Terms

All prices are F.O.B. Doniphan, Missouri. Missouri residents are subject to 5.725% sales tax. Please add 5% for packaging and handling materials (minimum charge of \$5.00). Shipping is via standard LTL next day freight or UPS ground service unless another method is requested. Shipping will be billed at cost.

Prices are subject to change without notice. Orders are filled on a first come, first serve basis and all current inventories are based on field estimates until harvest and processing are completed. We process our seedlings in bundles of 25 plants per bundle. When ordering please make all requests in multiples of 25 plants per variety. We would ask for at least three (3) days prior notice before pickup, so that we can have your order ready for you.

We will hold all paid in full orders for customers in our cold storage facilities as long as necessary in the spring due to late planting conditions resulting from high water, equipment availability, etc. All orders must be paid in full no later than April 1, regardless of how long they remain in our cold storage.

Orders under \$500 require payment in advance. For orders over \$500, a cash payment of 25% of total is required to book and hold an order. The balance is due prior to shipment unless approved by our office in advance of the shipping date. Late payments are charged at 2% monthly on the outstanding balance.

Every effort is made to insure materials are true to name and size. However, Ripley County Farms makes no warranty regarding its products for productivity, survivability or any other type of guarantee, expressed or implied. Orders will be shipped in good condition and in proper packaging to extend the viability of the living plant material. Orders are accepted subject to crop conditions. Ripley County Farms, LLC shall not be liable for non-performance due to labor shortages, weather conditions affecting stock losses in storage, delays in transportation, or other acts over which Ripley County Farms, LLC has no control.
